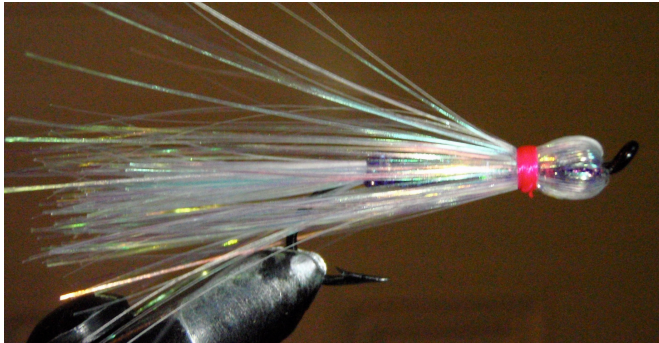


Crystal Bullet (PM Salmon Streamer)

Learned at Salmon Camp, Baldwin Michigan - tied by Wes Krupiczewicz



Hook: #2 or #4 heavy wire Streamer or Salmon Hook

Thread: 3/0 or flat waxed nylon fluorescent pink

Body: Various colors of sparkle braid or pearl diamond braid

Wing and tail: Pearl Flashabou and/or Glow in the Dark Flashabou

Technique is everything in tying this fly:

1. Start with a hank of pearl flashabou about 4 times longer than the shank of the hook. Tie in the flashabou so that about 1/4 of the length extends past the hook to the rear and about 1/2 of the length extends forward past the eye.
2. Wrap the sparkle braid body forward and form a ball head at the eye of the hook; leave the thread behind the ball head.
3. Pull back the flashabou extending forward of the eye and form a bull-nosed head and wing with the flashabou completely and uniformly covering the sparkle braid ball head.
4. Wrap a thread collar behind the head and tie off.
