

TRANSLUCENT “NUKE EGG”

Egg patterns catch a lot of fish all year long and are particularly effective in the spring and fall. By adding a veil of translucent yarn over a solid core makes the egg pattern more lifelike. This recipe is based on the “Nuke Egg Fly” by Ted Kraimer at Current Works. Changing the core and veil color gives you a lot of options.

Dry Fly, as tied:



Wet Fly:



Hook: Tiemco TMC 105 or Mustad C67S size #10

Thread: 6/0 to match veil

Core or Yolk: Orange McFly Foam (or color of choice)

Veil: Oregon Cheese Egg Fly Yarn (or color of choice) about 3/4” teased out
