## Foam Back Humpie

## tied by Gerry McDaniel



Hook: #8 Dry Fly Hook

Thread: 6/0 Black

Tail: Moose Body Hair

Back: 2 mm Foam about 3/16" wideBody: 4 strand Red Floss over foam

Wing: Calf Tail Hair Hackle: Grizzly and Brown

## Procedure:

- 1. Stack tips of the Moose hair and tie in the tail about 1 hook shank long
- 2. Trim foam to form a point; tie in rear ward about 1/3 back from the hook eye and secure with tread wraps.
- 3. Tie in Floss at tail and over wrap the foam on the hook shank.
- 4. Cut about 1/8" diameter calf hair, remove the shorts and stack the tips. Tie in about 1 hood shank long with the tips facing the tail. Pull the wing up by wrapping a thread dam at the rear base of the wing and then split the wing using x-wraps and post wraps.
- 5. Pull Foam forward and tie behind the wing.
- 6. Tie in the Grizzly and Brown Hackles behind the wing. Wrap hackles twice behind the wing and 3 times in front of the wing.
- 7. Whip finish a small head at the eye of the hook.
