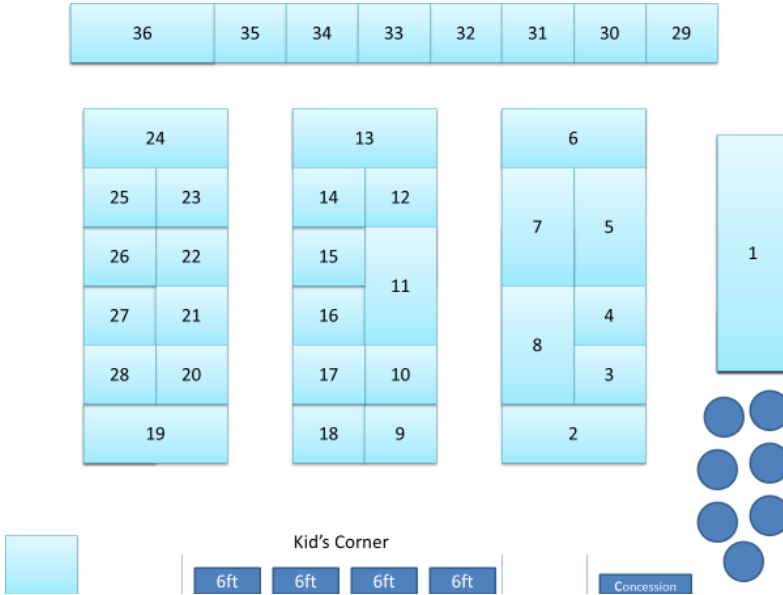
12:30 – 1:30: Brad Redmon
