(Reel Recovery is a national non-profit organization that conducts free fly-fishing retreats for men recovering from life-threatening cancer.) This fun fly fishing tournament took place on Saturday, November 21st, 2015 at Otter Creek Outdoor Recreation Area and by all accounts was a tremendous success. A total of 85 people registered and/or contributed to this worthy event and on the day of the tournament we had 25 teams (50 fishers) competing. This year's "Mystery Fly" was a size 10 Jig style Hare's Ear nymph. The 2015 winning team was Kelly and Rob McDowell. Kelly and Rob now have bragging rights, at least until next year, and each got a beautiful hand made engraved plaque evidencing their achievement. Congratulations!!

Participants and friends came from near and far and we had 7 different fly fishing clubs/organizations represented in this year's tournament. (MVFF - Miami Valley Fly Fishers, Dayton OH), (NKFF - Northern Kentucky Fly Fishers, Hebron KY), (OVFRC - Ohio Valley Fly Rod Club, Evansville IN), (IFC - Indianapolis Fly Casters, Indianapolis IN), (TU - Trout Unlimited, Louisville, KY), (WKU - Western Kentucky University, Bowling Green KY), (DCFF - Derby City Fly Fishers, Louisville KY). Thirty nine (39) patrons made this event a weekend trip by spending Friday and/or Saturday night(s) in the bunkhouses at the campground area at Otter Creek Park.
