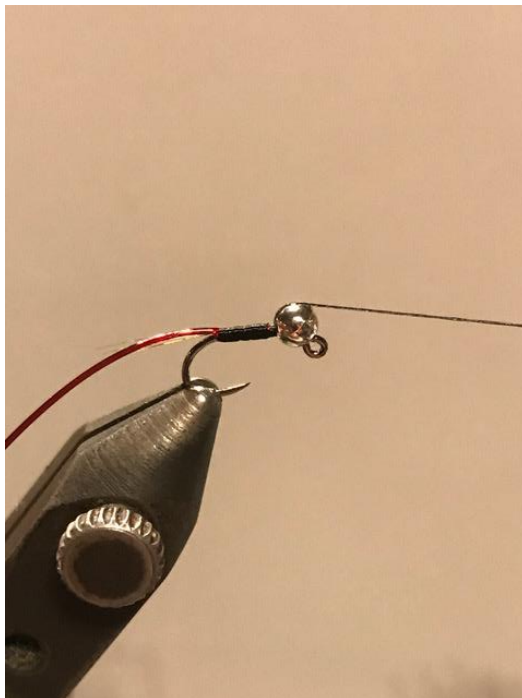

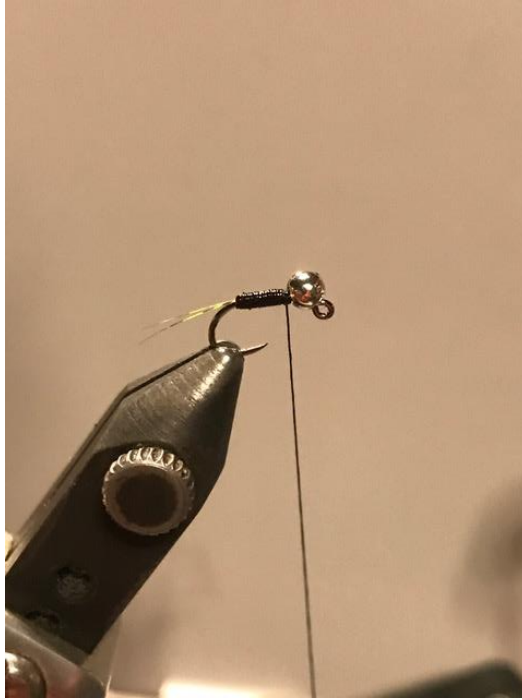
Get your 8/0 or 70 denier thread started with a size 18 jig hook and a 3/32 slotted tungsten bead.



Tie in a few (3-4) fibers from a Coq De Leon feather tail should be one hook shank in length.



Tie in some size “micro” Stretch tubing. Make sure the butt goes all the way up by the bead.



Wrap the stretch tubing in touching turns, forming the body of the fly, and tie off at the bead.



Apologies for the blurry photo, this was done in the dining hall at Camp Buffalo Bill.

Dub a sparse collar and whip finish. It is a pattern that is easy, fast, and productive. I caught my fish on one with a black body
