EZ Marabou Streamer




Materials


- Hook: Size 2 thru 10 streamer hook 3XL or 4XL.
- Thread: White 3/0 or 6/0
- Eyes: Silver dumbbell eyes (sized for hook size)
- Tail: White marabou
- Tinsel: Silver Krystal flash
- Body: White speckled chenille
- Wing: White marabou



Place hook securely in vise jaws.



Start thread behind eye of hook and remove excess.



Place dumbbell eyes approximately 1/8 inch behind eye of hook and secure with thread.



Position thread near bend of hook



Place a bundle of marabou and secure to hook shank with thread, Tail should extend past end of hook about the one length of the hook shank. Cut off excess marabou with scissors.



Tie in 2 pieces of Kystal flash to each side of hook, trimming length to slightly past end of tail.



Tie in chenille at rear of hook and move thread to behind the dumbbell eyes.



Wrap chenille forward on hook shank stopping at dumbbell eyes.



Secure chenille with thread and trim off excess chenille.



Tie in marabou to form wing on bottom of hook behind dumbbell eyes, then remove excess marabou. Length of wing should be slightly longer than hook shank.



Form head of fly in front of dumbbell eyes then whip finish.



Cut thread and bobbin free. Apply head cement to secure knot.
